Part 12: "The Church" The Text: Revelation 1:4 – 2:7
1:4 – The of Churches "Churches" = ekklēsia = a gathering or assembly of people together a 'called out' group
The 'Church' is the called out of Christians Acts 14:23, Acts 16:5, Romans 16:4, Romans 16:5, Romans 16:16, 1 Corinthians 4:17, Galatians 1:2, etc

The 'Church' can also refer to the called out of God Ephesians 1:22-23 – "And hath put all things under his [Christ's] feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all."
1 Corinthians 1:2 – "Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord"
Note: It is perfectly to use the term 'church' to refer to all Christians everywhere, but overwhelmingly, the term 'church' (ekklēsia) refers to a <i>local assembly</i> . When the Bible does refer to ALL Christians, it more commonly uses terms like 'Body of Christ' or 'the Family of God.'
This is where the word 'catholic' comes in! It is from the Greek 'katholikos' meaning "on the whole, in general." It is not used in the Bible, but early Christian writers used this term as a useful way to clarify whether they

When the early Christians used the term "catholic," they were not referring to any particular church or denomination – but to *all the saved*!

were talking about the local church ekklēsia, or the catholic church

ekklēsia (all those saved by Jesus, all over the world).
