The Text: 2 Peter 3:1-14

3:1-2 – Remember the Absolute _____ of the Bible

2 Peter 1:21 – "For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved (*pherō* / ferro= *carried, conveyed like a ship by wind*) by the Holy Ghost." (see: **2 Timothy 3:16**)

And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”
